
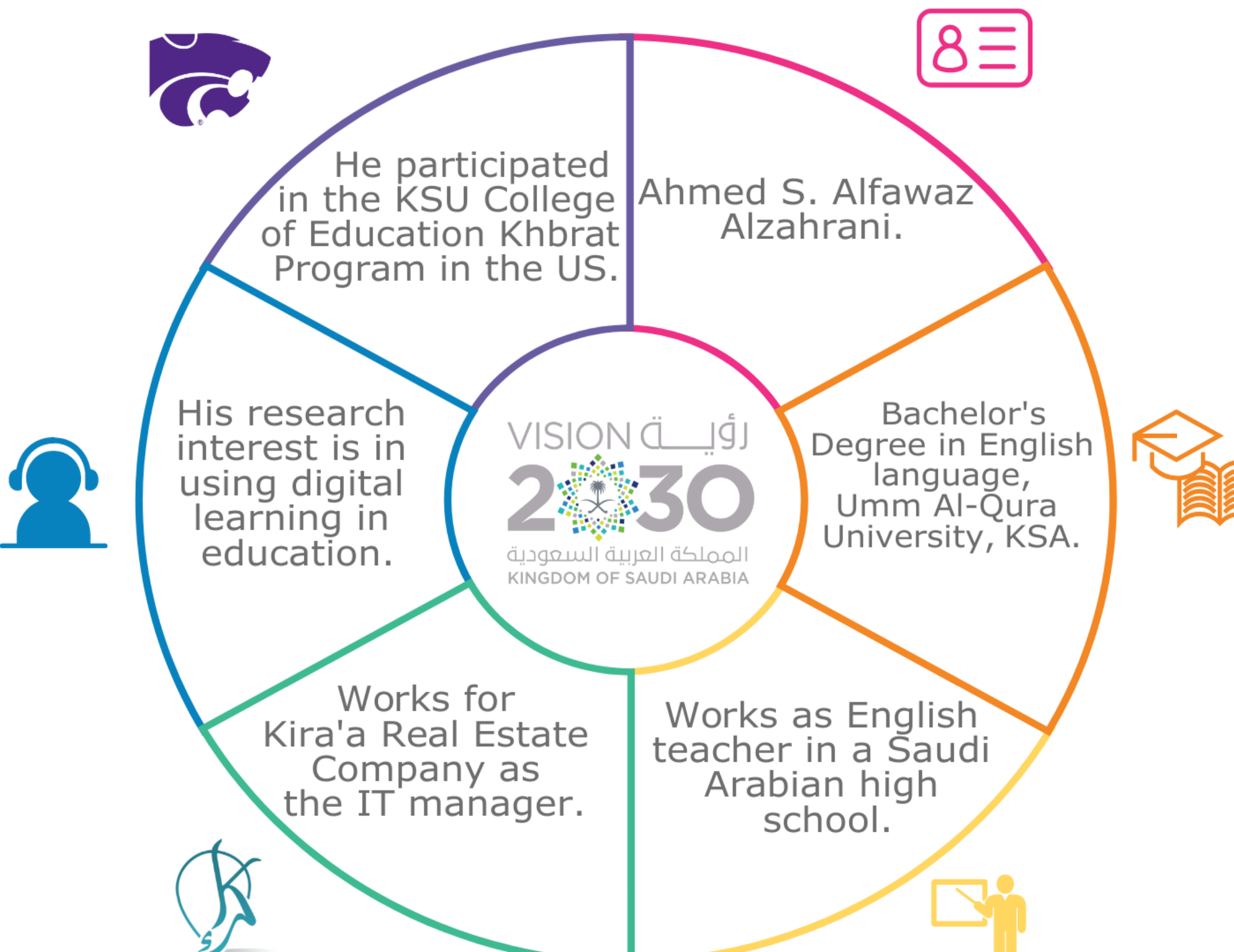

### Abstract

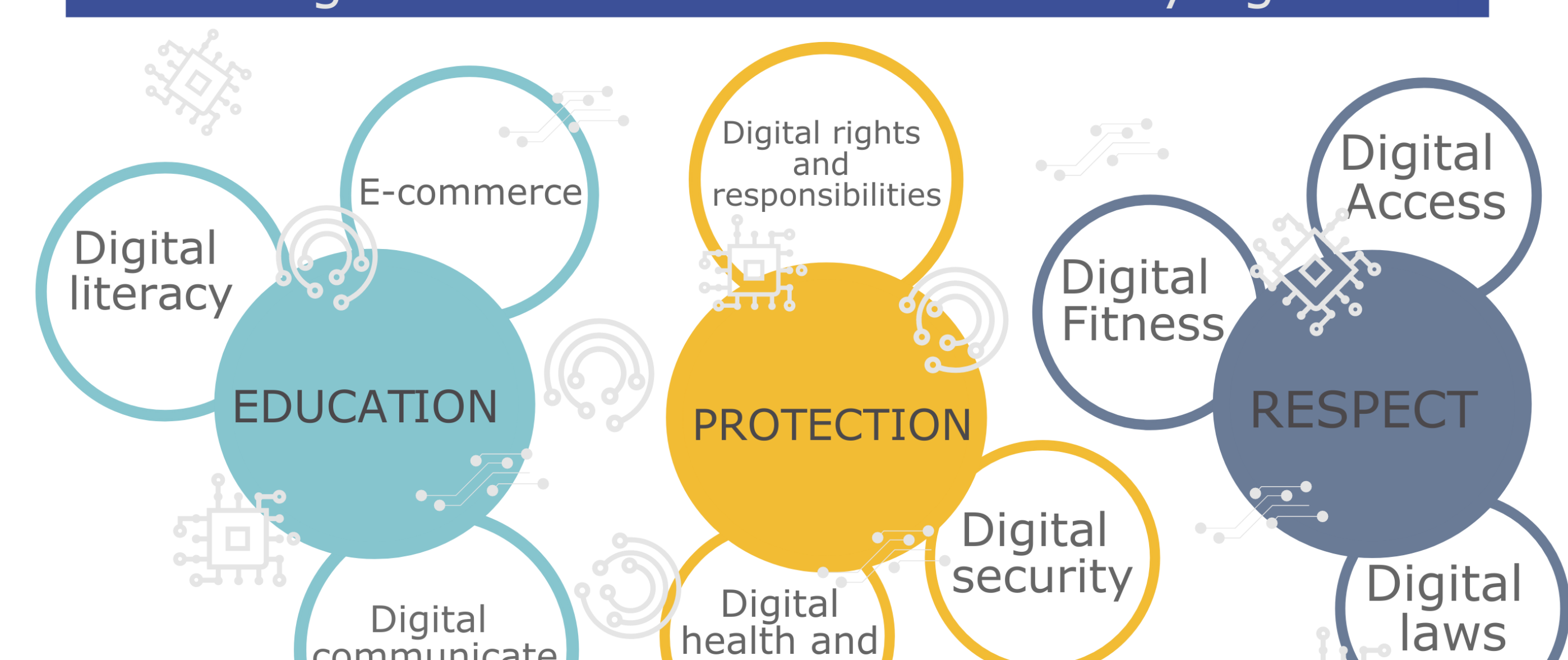
The technology and information revolution carries with it many advantages and disadvantages for the individual and society.
