# 4) 2019/2020 PTG Committee Reports

## a) PTG Events Overview

#### b) Tiger Shop Report

Safy Rizk recently accepted the role of Tiger Shop Manager after Fernanda Castillo stepped down. The Tiger Shop continues to be an important component of the PTG framework and has had another successful year both financially and by providing an opportunity for parents to volunteer and connect to the PTG.

The mains goal moving forward will be to expand the PTG brand through signage and grow the product list. The Tiger Shop will continue to maintain an environmental focus through the second-hand uniform sales and clothing donations to Second Chance charity. It is planned that an online ordering and payment system will be introduced. It is hoped that secondary students will become more involved in product design to encourage involvement.

#### c) Financial Report

The PTG started the 2019-2020 academic year with 385,000 baht in the account and ended with around 290,000 baht. Currently, the main source of revenue for the PTG is the Tiger Shop.

After the second year in a row of not being able to hold Fun Day PTG funds were reduced considerably. Even though we were not able to go forward with some planned events and support parent activities the PTG was still able to contribute to the school community in many ways.

For Example, the Tiger Shop, PTG Big Night Out, International Day, CAT's Sponsorship, Welcome Packs for New Parents and Grad 13 Leaving Gift.
