
COVID-19 Community Support Plan - Students

High Risk Contact

- Students who work at the same table (same pod) with a COVID-19 patient.
- Students who do not wear a mask and have a conversation with a COVID-19 patient within a distance of 1 metre or less for more than 5 minutes.
- Students who do not a wear mask and stay in a closed area with a COVID-19 patient within a distance of 1 metre or less for more than 15 minutes.
- Students who do not wear a mask while being near a COVID-19 patient when he/she coughs or sneezes.
- Students who live with a COVID-19 patient, in the same household.

Low Risk Contact*

- Students who have close contact with high risk contact students.
- Students who participate in other activities with a COVID-19 patient but do not meet any of the high-risk criteria.

No Risk Contact*

- Students who have close contact with low risk contact person.
- *Low Risk Contact and No Risk Contact: Continue to study onsite

- (1) Deep clean classroom (s) or infected area by housekeeping team
- (2) Principal informs parents:
 - High Risk Students in the classroom / year group
 Quarantine 14 days / appropriate testing / CSL resumes / contact the School Nurse if student or any family members in the household develops COVID-19 symptoms
 - Low Risk Students in the classroom / year group
 Safe to continue learning on-site after 3 day closing but if any parents wish to keep their child
 at home for observation, they can inform the class teacher
- (3) The School Nurse calls individual parent of High Risk Students, provide quarantine including testing guideline (No Symptom: ATK on Day1 and Day13 / With Symptoms: RT-PCR Day1), and criteria to return to campus
- (4) Each Principal inform Primary School and Secondary School for updating
 - If the positive case is in Primary, Principal will inform Primary staff and parents
 - If the positive case is in Secondary, Principal will inform Secondary staff and parents
 - If the positive case is in Cross Campus, Principal will inform Cross Campus staff

Remarks:

- One COVID-19 patient in a class: This class is cancelled on-site for 3 days, CSL resumes.
- Low Risk Contact: Return to on-site classes after 3 days.
- High Risk Contact: Remain guarantined for 14 days.
- More COVID-19 patient(s) in more than one class: On-site classes are cancelled for entire Year group for 3 days, CSL resumes.
- Low Risk Contact: Return to on-site classes after 3 days.
- High Risk Contact: Remain guarantined for 14 days.
