### Listen to others

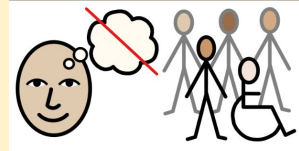
It's okay to challenge a view or disagree, but we listen properly before making assumptions or deciding how to respond. Everyone has the right to feel listened to.

We can explore beliefs and misunderstandings about a topic without fear of being judged.

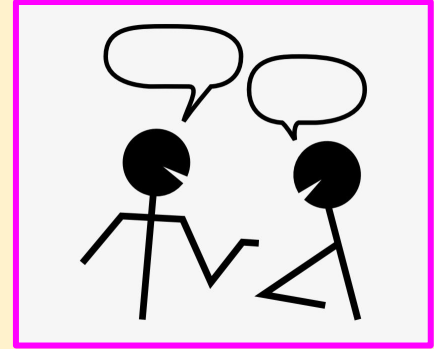
### Right to pass

Every student has the right to choose not to answer a question or join in the discussion if a topic makes them uncomfortable.



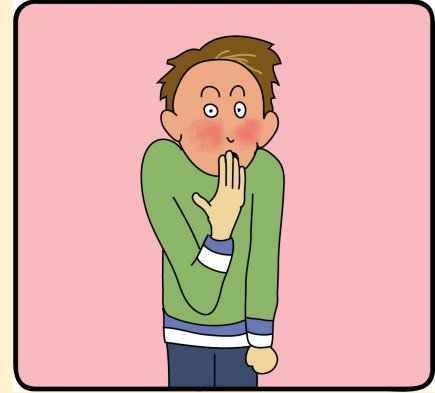

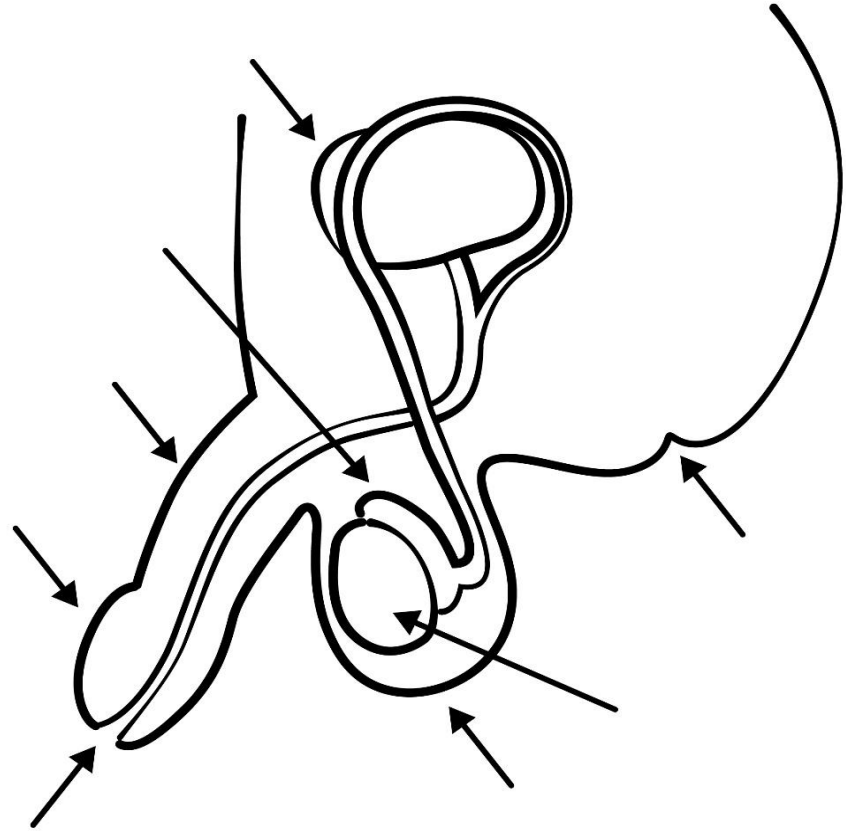

# Vocabulary - checking understanding

erection

- the muscles surrounding the penis allow more blood to enter
- the penis become stiff, erect, and stand out from the body
- can last from a few seconds to a half-hour or more and can happen at any age

sperm

- The male ingredient needed to make a baby.
- Produced in the testicles.
- You make about 100-300 million sperm each day.
- Sperm travel through the epididymis, through the vas deferens and mix with fluid: this mixture is called semen.

semen

- Semen is a cloudy, whitish, sticky fluid.
- Sperm leaves the male body (in semen) during ejaculation

ejaculation

- usually happens when the penis is erect.
- When a male ejaculates, semen squirts from the opening of the urethra at the end of the penis.
