Please could your child bring a backpack into school with a selection of the gifts listed below inside that are appropriate for the child's age group:

- Hygiene items such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, soap or small towels
- Clothing such as socks or t-shirts

- Schools Supplies anything they may need in school such as pencils, rubbers, coloured pencils
- Toys soft toys, balls and easy books to read

DO NOT INCLUDE

- -anything that has already been used or damaged
- -any war related items such as knives, toy guns etc.
- -anything breakable or that needs batteries to work
- -any electrical items
- -No food or liquids (drinks)

Please do not wrap the backpacks. Attach a small note with your child's name and class on the front and a Christmas greeting. E.g. 'Happy Christmas'.

Please send your contribution to the school by **Monday 2nd December** at the latest.
