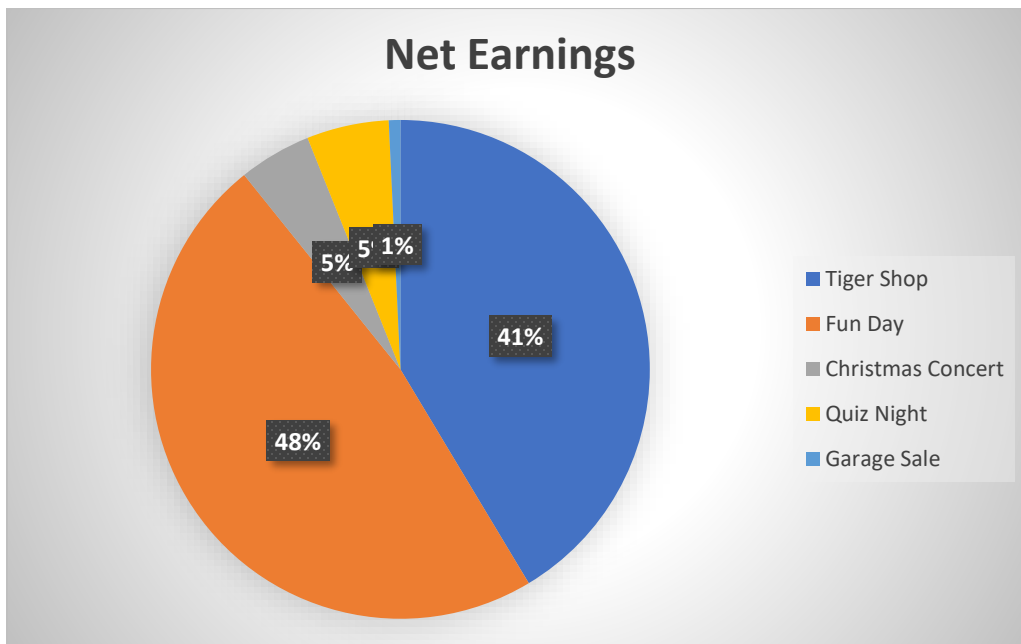
### **Treasury Report – Dennis Stech**

Dennis thanked previous PTG Treasurer Pook Sapayanon for her support as he transitioned into his first full year in the role.

Highlights from the year included:

- 450,000 THB net income from Fun Day, less than the last academic year due to fewer big sponsorships. He views this as an opportunity to target smaller sponsors next year
- 45,000 THB net income from the Christmas concert
- For International Day, PTG increased the subsidies for the smaller countries (those with less than 50 families), allowing PTG to shoulder more of a financial burden
- Big Night Out had a net loss of about 5,000 THB
