



RE: Primary Mid-Year Reports 2025-26 now available on Firefly

Dear Parents,

Primary Student Mid-Year Reports are now available to view and download through Parent Firefly Page. These reports reflect your child/ren's progress and attainment for Term 1 of the academic year. When reading the report, please do celebrate your child's successes as they have most certainly worked hard this term. Remember, progress looks different for every child and is liminal, not linear.



Progress Tests in English and Mathematics

For children in Key Stage 2, the report now includes scores from the GL Progress Tests in English and Mathematics. These assessments provide a score called the Standard Age Score (SAS). The SAS shows how your child's test result compares to other children of the same age across the world.

SAS Score	Banding	What it Means
Below 74	Very Low	Much lower than average
74 – 85	Below Average	Lower than average
89 – 111	Average	Similar to most children
112 – 126	Above Average	Higher than average
Above 126	Very High	Much higher than average

Where an SAS is marked as **N/A, this shows where a student did not complete the assessment. Should you have any further questions about your child/ren's report please contact their class teacher, who will be happy to support your understanding of their learning and progress.
