We are delighted to invite you into a special visitor-led workshop as part of our Primary Science Week (Feb 23rd to 27th). Piers Baillie is the founder of Global Reef, an organisation based in Koh Tao that aims to connect a global audience with the marine world through research, education, and innovative technologies. Piers will be in working with students across the primary school as part of our marine biology focused Science Week. Piers' work is also linked to the UN's 14th Sustainable Development Goal: looking after life below water, which was the focus of this year's Waste Less Week.

In the session, Piers will share some of the marine conservation work Global Reef are doing in Thailand, including artificial reef projects; shipwreck research, which has recently been featured in the media; and their ongoing work on coral thermal tolerance, which is exploring potentially bleaching-resistant reefs.
