- Important Notes on Registration and Payment :

1. Registration must be made through the link provided above

There are two payment methods:

- Pay directly on the registration system during the sign-up process.
- Follow the payment instructions in the confirmation email (via PayPal or bank transfer).

**In this case, you must upload the payment proof to the registration system with details of instruction from our email.*

2. Only students whose registration and payment status are confirmed in the registration system will be considered successfully registered.

If a student pays via PayPal or bank transfer but fails to upload the payment proof to the system, we will not be able to verify the payment, and their registration will be invalid.
