Problem Solving in Mathematics **Tuesday 31st March | Primary Hall (8.00–9.00am)**

We would like to invite you to a Mathematics Curriculum Workshop focused on a key aspect of your child's learning: problem solving.

Problem solving in primary school involves applying mathematical knowledge to unfamiliar or more complex situations. Through problem solving, children develop resilience, independence and confidence, learning to persevere when a solution is not immediately clear. At Bangkok Patana, we are committed to an inclusive approach in which all children, regardless of age or attainment, engage with problem solving; our tasks are carefully designed so that every learner can access the mathematics and think deeply at their own level.

During the workshop, you will:

- Gain a clear understanding of what we mean by problem solving in mathematics
- See how this develops alongside fluency and reasoning
- Explore the types of tasks children encounter in lessons
- Learn the tools and techniques we use to support logical thinking

This will be a practical session. You will have the opportunity to try out a range of problem-solving activities yourself, similar to those your children experience in class. This will give you a deeper insight into the level of challenge, the thinking involved, and how we support children to persevere and succeed. We will also share simple, practical ways you can support your child at home, particularly in developing confidence, resilience, and a positive mindset towards mathematics.
