Schedule and Participation

- Year 4: 1.15 – 2.00

In recognition that Year 6 students have already invested great energy into their Matilda production, participation in Busking Day is optional. If your child chooses not to perform, they will attend a viewing time set by their teacher and continue with their learning during their year group's performance session.

If your child wishes to perform, please take time to talk with them about their act; teachers will also support children in planning a performance that suits them—either solo or in a group. For those who prefer not to be on stage but would still like to be involved, we will ensure they have a meaningful and purposeful role behind the scenes.

We encourage students to practice at home and prepare any costumes or props in advance.
