Head of School Address – Chris Sammons

- **Secondary School:** A new building, the "Discovery Centre," is being opened to facilitate modern, 21st-century teaching methods.
- **Campus-wide:**
 - Ongoing development of sports facilities, including a new tennis center.

- The board is planning further building projects to enhance the students' experience.

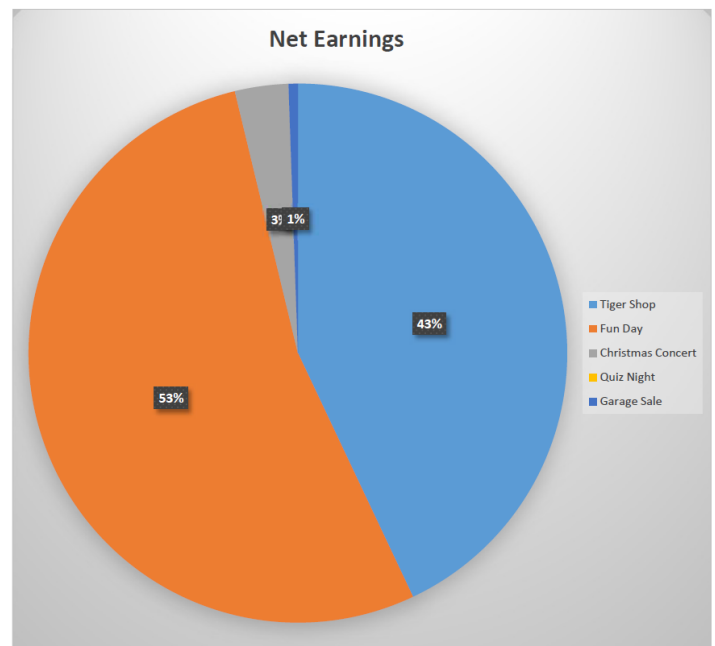
Treasury Report – Dennis Stech

The accounting period was changed to align with the school calendar (August to August).

- **Tiger Shop:**
 - Revenue decreases due to change in product lines, but profit was still consistent because of sales of old stock.
 - New products, such as wristbands and notebooks, were introduced.
- **Fundraising Events:**
 - **Fun Day:** A great success, generating 600,000 Baht in funds. Revenue was 1.9 million Baht with costs of 1.3 million Baht.
 - **Christmas Concert:** Generated revenue of 110,000 Baht and a profit of 40,000 Baht.
 - **International Day:** Costs increased to almost 200,000 Baht to provide more support for parent groups from smaller countries.
- **Charity Initiatives:**
 - Charity spending rose significantly to 120,000 Baht, supporting flood victims in Hatyai and other projects.
 - A school uniform donation project provided 3,000 children with uniforms at zero cost to the PTG.
- **Overall Financial Health:**
 - PTG funds grew from 1.4 million Baht to 2.449 million Baht as of May 6, 2026.
 - The group is well-funded for future operations and charity work.
